SUSTAINABLE FARM TOUR SERIES

Known & Grown launches St. Louis's only sustainable farm tour series featuring seven Known & Grown farmers in the greater St Louis area from an orchard in North City St. Louis to pastured livestock farm in Millstadt, Illinois.

Known & Grown's 2026 Farm Tour Series offers the opportunity to visit local farms in person, get a realistic look at what goes into creating the food we place on our tables, and get to know the real people who produce that food. This series of events features the diversity of working farms in the greater St Louis region including vegetables, livestock, mushrooms, fruits, flowers, and more and showcases farming methods that combat climate change, foster biodiversity, and improve community resilience in the face of growing supply chain vulnerabilities. The ticket price honors a local farmer's time and expertise, helps them to diversify their revenue, and supports Known & Grown's ability to continue to offer farmer-focused, community-oriented programming. These are family-friendly events and a great outing for visitors of all ages, abilities, and interests. All are welcome.

The Farm Tour season kicks off with Known & Grown's Spring Farmer Festival on Sunday, May 3rd, from 1-4pm at Midtown Community Farm located in The Grove neighborhood of St. Louis.

The first Farm Tour is located at Coahoma Orchards in St Louis. This event takes place on the 1-year anniversary of the May 16th tornado that caused significant damage to St Louis, particularly in the communities of North St Louis. This tour will include reflections on the challenges faced since the storm and celebrate the determination that continues to drive recovery and growth. Despite ongoing issues—damaged homes and businesses, disrupted livelihoods, and the long road to rebuilding—and a lack of support, the community is no stranger to perseverance, and urban farms like Coahoma Orchards demonstrate that resilience.
